Frequently Asked Questions

1. Why attend All Starz 2016?

It is in your best interest to have your child attend All Starz 2016 for the following reasons:

2. Who are our All Starz Staff?

Our All Starz Staff consists of college students, local community professionals and teachers who have a broad range of knowledge, skills and experiences in the area of youth development.

3. What are the camp hours of operation?

The All Starz camp runs from 7:00am to 6:00pm, Monday thru Friday.

4. What about lunch?

Lunch is free, and is from 12:00-12:30pm for All Starz participants. Lunch and snacks are available for all children enrolled in the All Starz Summer Camp regardless of whether the student is enrolled in a half-day or full-day program. Your child may bring a bag of lunch if you wish, and eat during the scheduled All Starz lunch and snack breaks.

5. How are children supervised prior to the start of classes, during breaks, and after classes end?

Our All Starz staff will supervise drop-off, lunch, snack, and pick-up periods outside of the regular camp time. During these times, children have the option to participate in small group activities.

6. What do I do if bad weather is reported?

7. Do you allow electronic devices to be brought to camps?

All Starz staff has planned a very busy schedule for the children so it is in the parents' best interest to leave all electronic devices at home. Cellphones are welcome but **must** remain in the child's backpacks during camp sessions. Excelsior International Academy is not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken devices.

8. Who do I call if I need to talk to All Starz staff during programming times?

You can call the All Starz main receptionist at (754) 205-2427 during normal business hours.

9. When is camp tuition due?

Camp tuition is due on a weekly basis. Tuition must be paid in advance on **MONDAY** for the current week. If tuition is not received by the close of Tuesday, a \$25.00 fee will be added to your account and your child may not return to camp until the tuition plus late fees have been paid. Payments are accepted in the form of cash, credit card or check. A \$35.00 fee will be applied for returned checks. If at any time the bank returns a parent's check, all future tuition payments must be made by cash, certified check or credit card. Tuition is due regardless of absences or national holidays and will not be prorated.

10. What is the cancellation/refund policy?

We will gladly refund your class registration fee if you cancel and request a refund 5 business days prior to the first class. We reserve the right to cancel a class due to low enrollment. In that case, we will call and make arrangements to refund your class fee.
